Competition / Match Secretary's Report 2013 -2014

Once again we find ourselves at the end of another season.

Whilst we take the time to reflect on the past season, one thing that stands out, is the closeness of the Trophies again, with attendance up in some matches and down in others, the competition remains high. Most of the cups were only won on the last match and the overall Beach Champion was only decided in the last match with both Ken and his son Graham both on 91 points each, well done Kenny on taking the championship..

There were some good catches over the season:

September saw a good Species match with Dogfish, Soles, Pout Eels Whiting and Cod – both Dave Wright and Graham Messenger had four fish but Dave had one pound more in weight.

Top catch was just under ten pounds in October on a Tuesday by Cameron (well done mate, last time I tell you how to fish my spot!)

Pegged matches were dominated by small whiting and codling with Mr Austin the master in these winning most of them.

A few matches after Christmas saw 20 anglers fishing and the Tuesday Evening Matches in the Spring/Summer were run along with Steve Adams Matches which although it is a higher entry fee (£10.00) it meant that payments were better and the club made one pound per head. Feed back on this at the AGM would be welcome as I would like to see this continue next season.

Cod Rover was well attended and was won with three fish for 5lb 1oz.

The Christmas and Easter Fayres were well attended and well contested it was also good to see seven juniors fishing. The Boxing Day match in the viewing area saw Thomas Boyt thrash us all with 63 points 27 points ahead of second place.

Clacton again produced but not the fish we have had in past years no dogfish eels or pout. But hopes were high as the week before there were loads of good fish coming out. We had a rover in July which was won with a nice bass and some eels it started at low tide so where to fish was key and a bit of pre-planning was done by Dave who outsmarted us all.

On a personal note this year has been hard for me and I never seem to have any time. I am happy to continue running the matches however your support and help is required, at times.

I also wish to record my personal thanks to our departing Chairman Dave Wright he and I stepped up to take up our roles at the same time 20 years ago, it feels like I am losing my wing man – thank you for your support Dave.

Well done to all the trophy winners – please come along to the presentation night where you will be awarded your trophies and also to those who have not been successful please come and enjoy a great night of fun and food. For some of you this might be the first handling of a fish this season.
